Here are your homework options

for this half term. Please complete two projects which are all linked to our new curriculum topic, That's All Folks. This is a creative topic that focuses on the history and development of animation and cartoons. We look at old and new animations like Mickey Mouse and Wallace and Gromit and you will also create your own stop-motion animations!

Design and label a new animated character for younger children.

Look at goodies and baddies in animated films and choose one to research and write about.

Create a story board for a scene – you could do this on paper or electronically.

Make your own flip-book animation or Zoetrope (like we have made in school).

Research your own choice of animated cartoon – we have looked at Mickey Mouse and Wallace and Gromit in school so choose a different one. Create a fact file all about the animation.

Draw your favourite cartoon character – be creative in how you present your artwork (paint, collage, charcoals, oil pastels...)

Think of a book that would make a good animated film. Storyboard the opening.

Create your own animation using a programme such as Scratch, I Can Animate or iMovie (there are plenty of others to choose from).
