At Witherley C.E. Primary School, we use technology to support learning. Here's what you need to know:

☑ Equipment

- Children must treat all devices with care.
- Damaging or changing equipment/software is not allowed.

☑ Printers

- Pupils are taught to press 'print' once and wait patiently.

☑ Internet Safety

- Internet access is filtered and monitored.
- Children are supervised online and taught how to stay safe.
- No chat rooms are allowed.

☑ Email

- Sometimes used for school projects under supervision.

☑ Learning Platforms

- Sites like Times Tables Rockstars, scratch, istopmotion, tinkercad, turtle logo and codu are used.
- Only Witherley pupils and staff may access them.
- Passwords must be kept private.

☑ Passwords

- Children receive simple, memorable passwords.

☑ Mobile Devices

- Phones, smartwatches, and similar devices should not be brought to school.
- Inappropriate content must be reported to staff immediately.
